REGISTRATION and CANCELLATIONS	<p>Race entry fee: 125€. Includes lift pass for the 2 race days (Saturday and Sunday) Race fees will be processed in GBP in the Eventbrite system. (based on the exchange rate as of January 18).</p> <p>Lift tickets for the race days are included in entry fee. Training day lift tickets for can be purchased onsite.</p> <p>Public entries will be available through an open lottery. Applications will be accepted at http://www.enduroworldseries.com/registration/ during a 24 hour period (January 25 00:01-23:59 GMT). Riders will be randomly selected and a link will be sent to successful riders on January 31 to enter and pay.</p> <p>Registration fees are refundable (less a 20GBP administrative fee) up to 3 weeks prior to the race. Cancellation request must be sent to athletes@enduroworldseries.com by 23:59 CET June 24. Entries are not refundable after June 25. Registrations are not transferable.</p>

LICENSE REQUIREMENTS	<p>The La Thuile Superenduro is sanctioned. Racers will be required to either have a current 2016 FCI / Enti della Consulta or a national UCI racing license to compete. No day licenses will be available.</p> <p>Only competitors holding an EMBA membership will be seeded for the start and eligible for Enduro World Series points and any associated Enduro World Series prize money or overall titles. A rider must hold a valid EMBA membership prior to starting the race in which they hope to win points. No points will be awarded retrospectively should a rider purchase an EMBA membership after an event.</p>

COURSE DESCRIPTION Detailed course maps / profiles will be included in the Race Book.	<p>Approximate amount of climbing: TBC Approximate GC time: 50mins. Terrain Type: Course will be a total of 6 stages (3 per day) and riders will do a mix of lift access stages and pedaled stages.</p>	
PROTECTION RULES	<p>While undertaking Special Stages it is mandatory to wear CE approved full-face crash helmet, gloves, knee-pads and back protector. It is mandatory to wear a helmet during the whole duration of the race, both during the transfers as well as during the special stages. A lighter XC version helmet may be worn during the transition stages.</p>	

**TRAVEL /
TRANSPORTATION**

La Thuile is easily reached from France and Aosta Valley. Closest international airports are Torino (TRN) and Geneva (GVA).

Teams and riders arriving from Aosta need to take Morgex highway exit and follow "Pre St. Didier" and then La Thuile. **ATTENTION : DO NOT FOLLOW NAVIGATION SYSTEM INFORMATION THROUGH "COLLE SAN CARLO"**. It is a narrow, steep and twisty road, not recommended for team vehicles and trucks.

Teams and riders arriving from the Mont Blanc Tunnel need to take highway exit Courmayeur, then follow "Pre St. Didier" and then La Thuile. Teams and riders coming from the Petit St. Bernard Pass need to follow "Funivie" sign once in La Thuile.
