

Applications will be accepted at <a href="http://www.enduroworldseries.com">http://www.enduroworldseries.com</a> during a 48 hour period starting at 00:01 GMT December 7. Riders will be randomly drawn on December 11 for the available spots. The successful applicants will be contacted with the instructions to complete their entries. The unsuccessful applicants will be automatically added to the waitlist. Any remaining spots will be released to the public at the end of January.</p>
	<p><b>ONSITE CHECKIN / PLATE COLLECTION</b> Wednesday   15h00-18h00 (priority line for EWS Team riders) Thursday   8h30-12h00 and 15h00-18h00 Friday   8h30-12h00* *Deadline. Riders who have not collected plate / checked in by 12h00 will not be included on the Start List for Saturday.</p>
	<p><b>ENTRY FEE</b> EWS: 122.65 GBP Challenger: To be confirmed Entry fees will be processed in the central EWS entry system in Pounds Sterling. Total includes taxes and processing fees</p>
	<p><b>CANCELLATION POLICY</b> Registration fees are refundable (less an administrative fee) up to 3 weeks prior to the race. Cancellation request must be sent to <a href="mailto:athletes@enduroworldseries.com">athletes@enduroworldseries.com</a> by 23:59 UCT September 7. Entries are no longer refundable after September 8. Registrations are not transferable.</p>

	<p><b>EMBA MEMBERSHIP</b> EMBA memberships are optional - but only competitors in the EWS race holding an EMBA membership will: 1. be seeded for the start, and 2. be eligible for Enduro World Series points and any associated Enduro World Series prize money or overall titles.  A racer must hold a valid EMBA membership prior to starting the race in which they hope to win points. No points will be awarded retrospectively should a rider purchase an EMBA membership after an event.  EMBA memberships are valid for a calendar year (January-December). 2018 memberships can be renewed / purchased in January on the EWS site : <a href="#">LINK</a></p>
	<p><b>RACE LICENSES</b> The Finale EWS and Challenger enduros are sanctioned by the Italian Cycling Federation.  Racers are required to either have a current 2018 FCI / Enti della Consulta or a UCI license issued by their national federation. <u>No</u> day licenses will be available from the Italian Cycling Federation at the onsite checkin.</p>





	<p>NOTE: Riders with a FCI Amatori Junior Sport (JMT or JWS) license are not eligible to race the La Finale EWS.</p>

	<p><b>UPLIFTS</b> Shuttling permitted on sealed, public roads during training. Spaces limited - advance reservations strongly recommended.</p>
	<p><b>PROTECTION RULES</b> Full face helmet, knee pads, gloves and back protector mandatory on race stages during training and race. Open face helmets can be worn on transitions.</p>
	<p><b>TRAVEL / TRANSPORTATION</b></p> <p><b>BY CAR</b> Finale Ligure is accessible by car along the motorway (A10) Genoa-Ventimiglia with exit at Finale Ligure when coming from Genoa or from the French border, while following the (A6) and then (A10) for those coming from Turin. An alternative route is the main road Aurelia, but for much of the route follows the coast and crosses towns and is often characterized by more local traffic.</p> <p><b>BY TRAIN</b> The train station in Finale Ligure is located within 5min from the paddock area. For more information: <a href="http://www.trenitalia.it">www.trenitalia.it</a></p> <p><b>BY PLANE</b> The nearest international airports are in Nice France (NCE 130km away) and Milan (either Malpensa MXP 220 km or Linate LIN 205km ). There is also a national airport located in Genoa (70km from Finale Ligure).</p>
