

EWS Team and Reserved Entries: January 15-19. Eligible riders will be contacted directly.

Public entries for the EWS will be available through an open lottery. Applications will be accepted at <http://www.enduroworldseries.com> during a 48 hour period starting at 00:01 GMT December 7. Riders will be randomly drawn on December 11 for the available spots. The successful applicants will be contacted with the instructions to complete their entries. The unsuccessful applicants will be automatically added to the waitlist. Any remaining spots will be released to the public at the end of January.













	<p>ONSITE CHECKIN / PLATE COLLECTION Wednesday 15h00-18h00 (priority line for EWS Team riders) Thursday 8h30-12h00 and 15h00-18h00 Friday 8h30-12h00* *Deadline. Riders who have not collected plate / checked in by 12h00 will not be included on the Start List for Saturday.</p>
	<p>ENTRY FEE 122.65 GBP Entry fees include lift access the race days. Discounted tickets will be available on the training days. Entry fees will be processed in the central EWS entry system in Pounds Sterling. Total includes taxes and processing fees</p>
	<p>CANCELLATION POLICY Registration fees are refundable (less an administrative fee) up to 3 weeks prior to the race. Cancellation request must be sent to athletes@enduroworldseries.com by 23:59 UCT June 29. Entries are no longer refundable after June 30. Registrations are not transferable.</p>

	<p>EMBA MEMBERSHIP EMBA memberships are optional - but only competitors in the EWS race holding an EMBA membership will: 1. be seeded for the start, and 2. be eligible for Enduro World Series points and any associated Enduro World Series prize money or overall titles. A racer must hold a valid EMBA membership prior to starting the race in which they hope to win points. No points will be awarded retrospectively should a rider purchase an EMBA membership after an event. EMBA memberships are valid for a calendar year (January-December). 2018 memberships can be renewed / purchased in January on the EWS site : LINK</p>
	<p>RACE LICENSES The La Thuile Enduro World Series #5 is sanctioned by the Italian Cycling Federation. Racers are required to either have a current 2018 FCI / Enti della Consulta or a UCI license issued by their national federation. <u>No</u> day licenses will be available from the Italian Cycling Federation at the onsite checkin. NOTE: Riders with a FCI Amatori Junior Sport (JMT or JWS) license are not eligible to race the La Thuile EWS.</p>
	<p>COURSE Terrain Type: Course will be a total of 6 stages (3 per day) and riders will do a mix of lift accessed stages and pedaled stages. Course overview will be posted shortly.</p>





	Detailed course description and maps will be published Sunday July 15. Stages will be closed for riding until training on July 19-20.

 	UPLIFTS Course will feature a combination of lift accessed and pedalled transitions. Details to be confirmed. Lift tickets are included in the entry fee for race days. Discounted tickets will be available for the training days.
	PROTECTION RULES Full face helmet, knee pads, gloves and back protector mandatory on race stages during training and race. Open face helmets can be worn on transitions.
	TRAVEL / TRANSPORTATION Closest international airports are Torino (TRN) and Geneva (GVA). Teams and riders arriving from Aosta need to take Morgex highway exit and follow "Pre St. Didier" and then La Thuile. ATTENTION : DO NOT FOLLOW NAVIGATION SYSTEM INFORMATION THROUGH "COLLE SAN CARLO". It is a narrow, steep and twisty road, not recommended for team vehicles and trucks. If arriving from the Mont Blanc Tunnel, take highway exit Courmayeyr, then follow "Pre St. Didier" and then La Thuile. If coming from the Petit St. Bernard Pass, follow the "Funivie" sign once in La Thuile.
